
#### Report on Activities Carried out for World Hearing Day 2021

## 1. Development of Public Education Materials in Six languages





# 2. Walk-a-thon on the Occasion of World Hearing Day 2021 with theme of "HEARING CARE FOR ALL"

#### 3. Free Hearing Screening Camp

The institute has conducted a Free Hearing Screening Camp on the occasion of World Hearing Day 2021 from 01<sup>st</sup> March 2021 to 6<sup>th</sup> March 2021 in association with Sivantos India Pvt Ltd, Bangalore. During this free camp, all the hearing tests such as pure tone audiometry, immitance audiometry, auditory brainstem response, and otoacoustic emissions tests were done free of cost to the needy people along with audiological consultation and hearing aid trial. Discounts on various models of hearing aids were extended to the public in association with Sivantos India Pvt Ltd, Bangalore.


During the camp, free assessment services were also extended to children and adults with speech and language impairments. All the speech & language evaluations and speech language pathologist consultation was provided at free of cost. A total of 200 people with speech and hearing impairments were benefitted through this free speech and hearing camp at the institute. A two-day free hearing screening camp was also conducted at our outreach clinic in Davanagere, Karnataka on 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2021. A total of 100 people with

hearing impairment were tested freely and provided audiologist consultation. The faculty and students of our institute have participated in the camp at Davanagere, Karnataka.

# 5. Public Awareness Programs through Facebook Live

On 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2021, a Facebook live program was organized for 01 hour duration for public on the topic hearing and hearing disorders and their management by experts in the field of Audiology and Speech Language Pathology. The expert members elaborated upon the hearing and hearing disorders seen in newborns, children and adults and their effects on day to day living; the effects of hearing loss on child development in terms of speech and language, academics, social, etc in children; importance of early identification and rehabilitation of children with hearing loss, and management of hearing loss in children and adults. A question & answer session was also included and the panel members clarified the doubts of public on various aspects related to hearing loss and management of hearing loss.

#### 6. Press conference

A Press conference was organized on 27.02.2021 and on 02.03.2021 by inviting representatives from both Print and Electronic media to brief about the World Hearing Day 2021. Topics related to hearing and hearing disorders across lifespan and their identification and management were explained to the press and media persons. The press conference highlighted upon the World Hearing Day which is celebrated by World Health organization on 03<sup>rd</sup> March every year and the need for conducting such events to increase the public awareness. #### 7. Orientation to healthcare professionals



A series of webinar programs on topics related to hearing – assessment and management were conducted for healthcare professionals.


• 1st Webinar on Cochlear Implants – Role of Audiologist: On 22nd February 2021, first webinar on Cochlear Implants – role of audiologist was conducted for students and professionals of audiology and speech language pathology. Mrs. T. Muthuselvi, Assistant Professor, Department of Speech Language and Hearing Sciences, Sri Ramahcandra Institute of Higher Education and Research, Porur, Chennai served as the resource person. The webinar highlighted upon the candidacy for cochlear implant, factors affecting cochlear implantation, role of audiologists in intraoperative and post surgical mapping procedures, demonstration of softwares used in cochlear implant mapping, details about success rates, and auditory verbal training. Over 150 students from various speech and hearing institutions and audiologists from different parts of India have attended the webinar.



• 2<sup>nd</sup> Webinar on Assessment and Management of Vestibular Disorders: On 24<sup>th</sup> February 2021, second webinar was conducted on "Assessment and management of vestibular disorders for students and professionals of audiology and speech language pathology. Mr. Suresh T, Research Coordinator and Associate Professor, Dr. S.R.C.Institute of Speech and Hearing, Bangalore served as the resource person. The webinar highlighted on anatomy and physiology of vestibular system, peripheral vestibular disorders, subjective and objective assessment of vestibular disorders, importance of multidisciplinary team approach, and management procedures for


